# **Gilad Atzmon**

Internationally acclaimed jazz saxophonist and composer Gilad Atzmon comes together with pianist-singer Rich Siegel to conduct a dialogue against war and apartheid.

The Guardian described Atzmon as "one of London's finest saxophonists [but] it is Atzmon's blunt anti-Zionism rather than his music that has given him an international profile, particularly in the Arab world, where his essays are widely read."

A prolific performer, composer, author and activist Atzmon brings his intellect and artistry to bear on the continuing occupation in Palestine. He will strip away the propaganda and the polemics in US-Israel relations that hide one simple fact: Palestinian people continue to live under occupation, financed by the United States, an occupation that builds roads they cannot use and houses in which they cannot live.

His recently released non-fiction work "The Wandering Who? A Study of Jewish Identity Politics" (Zero Books, 2011) is a well-researched, systematic approach to understanding the psycho-social dynamics of (in the words of Kathleen Christison) how so many Jews, believing themselves to be doing "what is good for the Jews," have managed to carve the heart out of the Palestinian nation and make this tragedy look like the natural order of things. This is modern Zionism.
